



PRAYING LIGHT INTO THE HINDU WORLD

Thursday, March 1

Pray for our Hindu Workers' Conference being held March 3 to 10 in India. Lift up Dr. Jeff Adams, Chairman of the Christar U.S. Board of Trustees, as he teaches. Pray for good health, safety in travel and good fellowship for workers attending, and ask God to encourage and give vision to our team.

Friday, March 2

Lift up workers as they guide several short-termers serving in South Asia. Ask the Lord to bless these trips and make them profitable times for both the short-termers and our workers, and to direct these short-termers as to how they might serve Him in the future.

Saturday, March 3

Fear and discouragement can paralyze. Pray that workers in India would not be discouraged by decreases in attendance at gatherings, but have the courage to boldly move forward.

Sunday, March 4

Pray with a worker in India for more customers and opportunities to share truth through his carpentry business. Ask God to lead him to prepared hearts, and also to bless his ministry of teaching and training national pastors.

Monday, March 5

Workers are encouraged that over 30 ladies attended a Christmas gathering at which the gospel was shared through henna designs, a popular form of skin decoration in India. Pray for the workers as they follow up by responding to the offers of dinner and chai tea they received as a result of this event.

Tuesday, March 6

Pray for a believing friend of workers in India as she faces severe opposition from her family, who don't allow her to attend Sunday meetings. Also, ask God to guide her regarding returning to her job, and pray for continued spiritual growth.

Wednesday, March 7

Praise God for healing a worker with Dengue Fever, and pray for opportunities for her to share with her landlord and neighbors.

Thursday, March 8

Praise God that the eye cancer of two of our workers' Indian friends is in remission. Pray for continued healing and opportunities to minister to this family.

Friday, March 9

Ask God to provide financially for a worker who's completing a furlough in Hong Kong and preparing for a semester of studies in the United States.

Saturday, March 10

Ask God to strengthen, encourage and give boldness to the Hindu-background believers in a cell group in the Netherlands. Pray for wisdom for our team as they strategize and plan in their efforts to help establish more cell groups.

Sunday, March 11

Pray for workers in England reaching out to their community through organizing a "Neighborhood Watch" program. Ask God to bring more believers and seekers to their monthly Bible study.

Monday, March 12

Pray for the women's Bible study group that has begun an outreach at a local women's jail, and praise God for the 14 inmates who attended the first meeting. Ask for God's touch on the lives of these women—during the prayer of repentance, all began to cry. Also, pray for favor with those in authority so that this ministry would be allowed to continue.

Tuesday, March 13

Pray for opportunities to share truth through classes at a worker's newly opened English Center in India.

Wednesday, March 14

Lift up several Indian friends our workers are counseling, including a believer who's married an unbeliever and an engaged couple from different castes that is waiting for their family's blessing on their marriage.

Thursday, March 15

Pray for more opportunities for a worker in India to share with the group of young ladies she's meeting with and for wisdom in relationships with friends. Also, lift up a friend this worker had to confront about some dangerous relationships and habits; ask God to work in her heart.



PRAYING LIGHT INTO IMMIGRANT COMMUNITIES IN NORTH AMERICA

Friday, March 16

Pray for workers in Virginia as they prepare for a short-term English-teaching ministry in Northern Iraq this summer, and ask God to raise up more men to join this team. Lift up the Muslims who heard the gospel through last summer's outreach, and pray for peace in this area of the world!

Saturday, March 17

Give praise with workers in New Jersey for good attendance at Christmas outreach events: the Turkish friends they invited brought some of their friends, resulting in more people hearing the gospel. Ask God to work in the hearts of all who heard.

Sunday, March 18

Pray for our worker who contacts 80 or more people in Turkey online every day.

Ask God to give him wisdom and safety and to move his friends along in their spiritual journeys.

Monday, March 19

Pray for workers who are involved with Prayer Impact Teams through their local church; these teams visit and seek opportunities to pray with the local immigrant population. Ask God to cause their efforts to bear fruit.

Tuesday, March 20

Pray for a Muslim-background believer who is facing financial pressures and conflicts in his family. Ask God to give our worker wisdom as he counsels and encourages this man over the phone.

Wednesday, March 21

Preparations for the celebration of the Persian New Year (March 21-April 1) begin today. Pray for workers who will be distributing Persian literature and DVDs in the Washington, DC area. Ask God to bless the activities and gatherings that will be held and to prepare hearts to receive His word.

Thursday, March 22

Lift up a Kurdish friend of our workers who has cancer of the heart and is unreceptive to the gospel, though her husband is a believer. Pray for her salvation and healing.

Friday, March 23

Pray for workers in Canada seeking to reach the Kurdish community. Give praise with us for a successful Christmas

program for their Kurdish friends and ask God to guide as they continue to build relationships and share the gospel.

Saturday, March 24

Pray for the emerging leadership in a Turkish church plant in New Jersey, and ask God to raise up more leaders. Also, ask God to bless our workers' ministries of teaching English and offering practical help to their Turkish friends.

Sunday, March 25

Ask God to guide workers who are assisting a believing friend through the long and difficult process of immigration to Canada. Ask God to lead, encourage and meet the needs of this brother.

Monday, March 26

Give praise for the opportunities workers have to minister in a Japanese community in Pennsylvania—30 to 40 Japanese families live in an apartment complex across from the church! Ask God to continue to bless and work through the English classes, Bible studies and children's classes being conducted to reach these families.

Tuesday, March 27

Pray that a worker will be able to share truth with a lonely Pakistani student in Kentucky.

Wednesday, March 28

Pray for workers in North America as they begin to prepare for Easter outreaches to Japanese, Kurdish, Turkish and Bengali communities. Pray for good

attendance and that the Holy Spirit will work in the lives of those who come.

Thursday, March 29

Ask God to use a special mailing of Farsi books, CDs, testimonies and children's literature to about 100 Persian churches in the U.S.

Friday, March 30

Ask God to guide workers as they share with the international community in Houston. They're prepared with evangelistic CDs in over a dozen languages to use when opportunities arise.

Saturday, March 31

Pray for clear guidance for workers who served in South Asia as they consider working with an Indian pastor in Chicago, while helping to recruit new workers at two colleges. This would allow them to minister to South Asians, learn from the pastor and possibly recruit a team to return to South Asia in the future. Also, pray for the health of their twin boys.
