





# Church Partnership





Christar workers are

sent by 175 churches and supported by 1,003 churches.

The local church's role in missions is

multifaceted, involving the entire body not only through sending but through prayer, giving and practical assistance. This partnership benefits not only those serving across cultures, but also supporting fellowships as churches broaden



Among the hundreds of thousands of Persian Deaf there are only about a dozen followers of Christ. The vast majority have never been introduced to Jesus and will remain unreached unless workers are sent to share the gospel with them in their distinct language and culture.

Through the Deaf Initiative, Christar is mobilizing Deaf believers—those who can most effectively convey the hope of Jesus among the Deaf—so that these least-reached people don't have to wait any longer to learn of the good news. It's our prayer that this initiative will both catalyze and fuel a movement within the global Church to bring the good news to Deaf communities around the world.


