Introducing the Story of Redemption

Since beginning online ministry in 2021, Scripture Engagement through Social Media (SESaMe) has given more than 28,000 people in Muslim communities access to the good news, and 16 people have professed faith in Christ.

A new outreach tool, One Story, will help share the big ideas of Scripture with more people who’ve never encountered God’s Word. It will showcase the broad theme of redemption in the Kingdom of God, tying together chronological biblical events with audio clips voiced by a native speaker to help these stories make sense to Central Asians.

Preparing New Workers for Effective Service

As local churches send cross-cultural workers to share the transforming love of God in least-reached communities, Christar comes alongside these men, women and families with specialized training and experience.

Through pre-field equipping pathways, workers learn communication and conflict-resolution principles and examine security and health concerns specific to their intended areas of service. They receive tools to help them build support teams and learn language and culture as they prepare to share the love of Christ in communities where the Church doesn't yet exist.

ABC Health Foundation

Modeling Compassion Through Medicine

The ABC Health Foundation is a bright light for the gospel and for quality, whole-person care in a region where patient-focused medical practice is scarce. Established in Albania in 1994, ABC practices and teaches excellence in health care, with values rooted in biblical principles. It also seeks to meet spiritual needs and partners with local churches to host community health programs. Through its services and partnerships, ABC sees an average of 50 or more people come to faith in Christ each year.

ABC also imparts a biblical worldview to health care providers through an internship program. Over the past 20 years, 20 medical doctors and three physical therapists have undergone this hands-on training. Graduates are equipped to provide compassionate care and to serve as ambassadors for a patient-centered approach in the medical community.

Together to Thrive

Supporting Workers for Thriving Cross-Cultural Ministry

God often strengthens His followers through fellowship with other believers. But for overseas workers in least-reached places, that refreshment can be scarce. Workers routinely face roadblocks, opposition and loss. Progress can be slow, and discouragement often seeps in. The Christar Mobilization Center U.S. (CMCUS) Member Care team comes alongside workers and provides resources, encouragement and support.

During home assignments, workers can attend a RENEW debriefing retreat hosted by the Member Care team, which provides a focused time for soul care. Five days of intentional respite enable workers to process their most recent term on the field, grieve in healthy ways and be refreshed, heard and encouraged.

The Barnabas Building

Building Gospel-Centric Community

In 2017 workers bought land in a rural South Asian community with a God-sized vision for transformational ministry—and ultimately for a thriving church to be established. The Barnabas Building represents a concrete commitment to invest in long-term relationships in this close-knit community. Construction began in 2021 and has provided jobs with fair pay and an environment where each employee is treated with dignity and respect.

When complete, the Barnabas Building will provide a spacious hub for hospitality, ministry and connection, housing a community library, café and dedicated space for ESL classes and training in areas such as agriculture, leadership, parenting and business, as well as living space for workers. And, by God’s grace, as the good news is rooted in hearts throughout the community, it will host this people group’s first worship gatherings for the church He is building.

Complete phase 2 of construction, including plumbing, electrical work and interior finishing to extend gospel access and hospitality in a South Asian community!
