June 2020

Cultivating Christ-honoring transformation

#### Monday, June 1

Lift up the many Muslims who were not able to observe Ramadan as they typically would due to COVID-19 restrictions. Pray they would understand that favor with God is a gift of His grace.

## Tuesday, June 2

Praise God for the testimony of a group of believers in Japan! Ask Him to make them bright lights for Christ in their community.

## Wednesday, June 3

Pray that those who planned to take short-term trips this summer but are unable to do so due to travel restrictions will have other opportunities to minister in this season.

## Thursday, June 4

Ask God to provide the funds needed to complete an Arabic translation of a book on abuse recovery from a biblical perspective.

## Friday, June 5

Pray that Kurdish believers will stand strong in the face of persecution.

## Saturday, June 6

Join a worker in South Asia in asking God to give many a hunger for spiritual truth in a community where few seem interested in the gospel.

## Sunday, June 7

Pray that participants in an online discipleship group for Central Asian believers will be encouraged by their study of Romans and their fellowship.

#### Monday, June 8

Praise God for giving a worker in the Far East the opportunity to teach a cohort of local believers preparing for cross-cultural ministry. Pray this training will greatly benefit their future service.

#### Tuesday, June 9

Lift up the least-reached\* people in France who have heard the gospel through virtual church services. Pray they will continue to be drawn to Christ and the peace He offers.

#### Wednesday, June 10

Praise God for enabling numerous Christar workers to minister in their communities through making and giving away masks. Pray recipients will understand that God's love motivates His followers' generosity.

# Thursday, June 11

Ask the Lord to overcome obstacles to the gospel in the Far East. Workers serving there share, "Ancestor and idol worship is deeply entrenched in the lives of the local people, and it is not easy for people to come to faith."

# Friday, June 12

Lift up new workers who have been delayed in leaving for the field due to international travel restrictions. Ask God to encourage them and give them understanding as they begin language study online.

# Saturday, June 13

Join workers in the Middle East in asking the Lord to raise up more faithful local believers to serve as leaders and role models.

# Sunday, June 14

Lift up the Roma families who've received food aid from Christar workers and their local partners. Pray they will be drawn to the love of God that was demonstrated to them.

## Monday, June 15

Pray for courage for Kurds in North America who are being drawn to Jesus but fear the consequences of turning away from the predominant religion of their community.

## Tuesday, June 16

Lift up the refugee ladies who have begun a Bible study that traces God's plan of redemption throughout history. Ask the Lord to continually bring truth from His Word to their minds.

# Wednesday, June 17

Pray that Christar workers will reflect God's peace in times of uncertainty. Workers in Central Asia share, "Our prayer is that we would walk worthy of the calling we have received and imitate our Master well, because people are watching and following."

# Thursday, June 18

Pray that Hindu-background believers in the Netherlands will stand strong in their faith and be used by God to draw their entire families to Christ.

## Friday, June 19

Ask God to work in the hearts of many in the Middle East as workers there share Bible stories in the local language.

# Saturday, June 20

On World Refugee Day, ask God to multiply the efforts of Christar workers seeking to meet the physical and spiritual needs of refugees.

# Sunday, June 21

On Father's Day, ask God to bring fathers in least-reached communities to faith in His Son and use them to lead their entire households to Him.

# Monday, June 22

Praise God for raising up refugee believers to serve Him, sometimes calling them to minister in the communities where they first encountered Christ. Ask Him to work through them in powerful ways.

# Tuesday, June 23

Pray for wisdom for workers seeking to develop an effective model for establishing churches among the Deaf throughout the Balkans.

# Wednesday, June 24

Praise God for providing resources that enabled workers in Southeast Asia to distribute food to refugees who have been out of work due to COVID-19. Pray for continued opportunities to reach out and share the good news.

# Thursday, June 25

Lift up the dozens of women who received counseling as a result of Arab Woman Today's abuse awareness campaign. Pray each will find healing and hope in Christ.

## Friday, June 26

Workers in numerous communities are seeking to offer training that equips entrepreneurs to start small businesses. Pray that this initiative will enable them to address the pressing need for employment while providing opportunities to share the hope of Christ.

# Saturday, June 27

Ask God to raise up 100 daily prayer partners for appointees preparing for the field.

## Sunday, June 28

Ask God to continue to provide for the needs of the many churches and individuals who support Christar workers and projects.

## Monday, June 29

Workers in Japan share that nearly all the members of two local church plants are the only Christians in their families. Ask God to give each one peace and opportunities to share that peace with others.

## Tuesday, June 30

Praise God for those who've accepted the gospel through social media outreach in the Middle East! Pray for wisdom in following up with those who have believed.
