#### Wednesday, September I

Lift up the children in the Middle East who attended a virtual camp over the summer, asking that they will remember what they learned and be encouraged to trust Jesus fully.

## Thursday, September 2

Thank the Lord for filling several vital positions within the Christar Mobilization Center U.S. (CMCUS). Ask Him to provide the right people to serve in several additional and greatly needed roles.

## Friday, September 3

Ask God to use workers in the Middle East to encourage and equip local pastors for effective ministry.

## Saturday, September 4

Join workers serving among a South Asian community in the United States in praying for wisdom and flexibility in planning outreach events.

## Sunday, September 5

Pray for wisdom as Christar seeks to partner with Deaf churches to take the gospel to the least-reached\* Deaf around the world.

## Monday, September 6

Happy Labor Day! Ask God to open doors for workers seeking to establish businesses around the world that provide opportunities to tangibly bless least-reached communities while sharing the hope they have in Jesus.

## Tuesday, September 7

Ask the Lord to use Christar mobilizers throughout this fall semester to help college students discover how He could use their gifts and skills to help take the good news to the least-reached.

#### Wednesday, September 8

Praise God for a new church of Persian believers—the first fellowship of its kind in a city in South America. Pray for wisdom for workers moving to this city to continue building the Body of Christ among Persians there.

#### **Thursday, September 9**

Join workers serving among Kurds in Canada in praying that those who have believed in Christ will truly desire to grow in love for Him and obedience to Him.

## Friday, September 10

Lift up the children in Japan who attended a day camp outreach over the summer, asking that they'll remember what they learned about Jesus.

## Saturday, September II

Pray for wisdom for field workers and those in the Christar Mobilization Center U.S. as they plan short-term trips for 2022.

## Sunday, September 12

Join workers serving among international students in praising God that numerous young people have returned to their home countries transformed by the gospel.

# Monday, September 13

Pray that this evening's online "Conversations With Christar" event will give participants a better understanding of ministry among the least-reached and encourage some to consider cross-cultural service.

## Tuesday, September 14

Praise God for blessing Perfectly Natural Herbs, a business owned by a church in the Philippines, enabling this company to financially support a network of seven local fellowships and outreach in numerous Muslim communities.

## Wednesday, September 15

Ask God to bring Hindu- and Muslim-background believers back to a church in the Netherlands and give them the grace to follow Him wholeheartedly.

## Thursday, September 16

Praise the Lord for the pastors and missions leaders participating in today's online Church Partnership summit. Ask that all will be encouraged and equipped to help their churches participate more fully in the Great Commission.

# Friday, September 17

Ask God to bring more young people with curious minds and open hearts to study the Bible with workers seeking to reach college students in the Far East.

## Saturday, September 18

Lift up workers who recently welcomed new babies into their families, asking God to give them grace and wisdom in parenting while living amid least-reached communities.

## Sunday, September 19

Praise God for a family that recently arrived in the Middle East to begin long-term ministry there! Pray for flexible minds as they start learning the local language and grace as they adjust to life on the field.

# Monday, September 20

Pray for wisdom for a worker in the United States seeking to see house churches of Persian believers established in his community. Ask the Lord to guide him and bring people interested in the gospel into his life.

# Tuesday, September 21

Ask God to continue to raise up more workers to share the gospel with Albanians living throughout the Balkans.

# Wednesday, September 22

Today, many in Japan pay respects to deceased ancestors as they observe Autumnal Equinox Day. Pray that faith in Christ will become part of the heritage of many Japanese families.

## **Thursday, September 23**

On the International Day of Sign Languages, ask God to raise up more workers who can share the gospel in the heart languages of the nearly 70 million least-reached Deaf.

# Friday, Sepember 24

Ask for wisdom for a team of workers seeking to establish an agricultural business that will enable them to bless a least-reached community and provide opportunities to share the good news.

# Saturday, September 25

Join workers serving in South Asia in asking God to raise up more workers to serve among a people group of 25 million people with no more than 50 known believers.

## Sunday, September 26

Pray that short-term workers who served alongside long-term Christar teams over the summer will retain the vision for the least-reached that they gained during this time of ministry.

#### Monday, September 27

Ask the Lord to provide full financial support and a least a hundred daily prayer partners for workers hoping to leave for the field by the end of the year.

#### **Tuesday, September 28**

Praise God for a group of approximately 60 believers from Central Asia who have been participating in a weekly online Bible study. Pray each one will grow in faith and share that faith with others.

#### Wednesday, September 29

Ask God to continue to bring Persians who are open to the gospel to an online outreach held every Wednesday evening.

## Thursday, September 30

Pray for continued encouragement and hope for workers who are unsure when they will be able to return to their countries of service due to pandemic-related complications.
