Inner Circle Requests

Pray as a mobilizer visits the IT (Intensive Training) Project, a seven-week program for college students focused on God's heart for the world. Ask God to facilitate good connections and use this time to encourage participants to seriously consider ministry among the least-reached.

Lift up the 14 workers participating in the RENEW retreat July 20-24. As they debrief from their last term on the field and consider their well-being, pray they will be refreshed and encouraged.

Pray for everyone involved in hosting RENEW, including the six member care staff, our U.S. director and his wife, and our third-culture kid coordinator along with her volunteer staff of five. Ask that the retreat will run smoothly as it's held at an off-site location for the first time.

Pray for mobilizers as they plan for the coming school year, and ask that they will effectively help believers considering cross-cultural ministry take steps forward during the summer.

Keep praying for the Finance Division, which has transitioned to numerous new systems and processes in recent months. Division staff would especially appreciate prayer that they'd prioritize challenges wisely and continue to make steady progress.

Praise God for five mid-term workers who, after two years of ministry on the field, have decided to serve with Christar long term. As they prepare to return, ask the Lord to give them good times with loved ones and provide their needed financial support.

Pray that those who explored our new <u>annual report</u> and <u>Transformation Update</u>, <u>All of Us</u>, in June will be encouraged by the ways God is using them in the Great Commission.

Lift up Christar's human resources generalist as she works through an SHRM (Society for Human Resource Management) certification process.

Continue to ask God to provide a total of 60 people to start the process of serving long term with Christar throughout 2025.

For Cross-Cultural Workers

Praise God for enabling workers in the United Kingdom to share the gospel with Muslims through a Torah discussion group. Pray that many who participate will come to know their Creator.

Pray for wisdom for workers running businesses in least-reached communities that employ people who've never before known a follower of Christ.

Praise the Lord for a new house church in a Muslim community. Ask God to give the believers who attend courage in living out their faith in a place where trusting in Christ often leads to severe persecution.

Ask for perseverance and encouragement for workers learning difficult languages so they can clearly share Christ with people who speak them.

Thank God for opening opportunities for workers in the Middle East to build relationships with leastreached people through playing and coaching sports. Pray that through these connections they'll be able to share the gospel with many in their communities.

For Missions-Minded Believers

Rejoice that the first followers of Christ from a people group in South Asia are boldly sharing their faith with their families! Pray that many others will become part of God's family through them.

Pray for courage, safety and freedom for believers in the Middle East who have been imprisoned because of their faith in Christ.

Praise God for 11 believers who recently completed a two-week training program in understanding Muslims and sharing Jesus with them. As they apply what they learned, pray that the Lord will use them in powerful ways for His Kingdom.

Ask the Lord to provide an Arabic-speaking pastor to shepherd a new church in Spain.

Praise God for bringing more Persian believers to a house church in an immigrant community in the United States. Ask the Lord to use their testimonies of His work in their lives to draw the seekers who attend to faith in Christ.
