Inner Circle Requests

Ask God to work through [Urbana](#), a missions conference for 17- to 25-year-olds, to inspire a new generation of cross-cultural workers. Pray that the Christar team that's participating will connect well with many young people who are interested in establishing churches in communities where they don't yet exist.

Lift up the mobilizers participating in the [Cross Con](#) conference in early January. Ask the Lord to use their efforts to raise up more young people to serve among the [least-reached](#).

Ask God to provide the funds needed for an aspiring worker to take a vision trip in the new year.

Pray for endurance and skill for the Finance team as they're busy with year-end activities such as the annual pre-audit.

Lift up several individuals who want to participate in Pre-Departure Orientation in January but need more pledged monthly support. Ask the Lord to meet their needs in His time.

Pray for discernment for the Christar U.S. director, Jim, as he manages numerous diverse projects at the end of the calendar year.

As we raise awareness about our new [Church Ministry Residencies](#), ask God to bring host churches and recent graduates to participate, as well as financial partners eager to [invest in the next generation of church planters](#).

Ask for wisdom for the Executive Team as they work on the 2026 budget.

Pray for those who will teach sessions at pre-field trainings in January, asking God to guide them as they prepare.

Pray for good rest for CMCUS staff members as most take time off at the end of December. Ask that each one would be refreshed and ready to minister effectively in the new year.

For Cross-Cultural Workers

Lift up a Roma church plant that began meeting in November. Pray that this fellowship will grow and expand the reach of the gospel within a marginalized community.

Praise God for six Persian believers in the United Kingdom who were recently baptized! Pray they will grow in their faith and for wisdom for workers in encouraging and discipling them.

Join workers in the Middle East in praying that God will bring like-minded believers to join their team.

Rejoice that a Persian church plant in the United States is growing in number and in maturity. Pray that the believers who attend will continue to share their testimonies and encourage others to explore following Jesus.

Pray for wisdom for Christar workers around the world in following up with those who express interest in the gospel at Christmas outreaches.

For Partner Churches

Pray that God will raise up a next-generation believer to serve as the new missions team chairman at an Indiana church so that the current chairman can step back into a support role.

Lift up a sending church in Iowa as they care for Christar workers during this family's first home assignment, asking that this would be a mutually encouraging and re-energizing time for these workers and their church family.

Pray for wisdom for a Pennsylvania pastor as he considers hosting a Christar Church Ministry Residency with a missions-minded couple in his church.

Ask God to deeply comfort a missions director in North Carolina who is grieving the loss of a field ministry role in the Middle East.

Lift up a Pennsylvania church that's celebrating the retirement of its senior pastor and welcoming a new pastor to fill this role. Pray for grace during this season of transition.

For Missions-Minded Believers

Praise God for volunteers who traveled to North Africa to provide child care while a team there received specialized training in sharing the gospel in the local dialect.

Pray for courage and protection for a young Kurdish believer who was recently baptized.

Ask the Lord to raise up national believers in Southeast Asia with whom Christar workers can partner in ministry.

Praise God for bringing local believers to help workers in the United States with a children's outreach in a Muslim community. Pray that through these volunteers, many in the community will experience the joy found in Christ and be drawn to Him.

Thank the Lord for local believers in East Asia who recently completed training in sharing the gospel. Ask Him to use them to bring many people in their communities to faith in Christ.

For the CMCUS*

Lift up the new workers attending pre-field training in January. Pray that each one will be well-equipped and encouraged for his or her next stage of ministry.

Ask God to guide the Communications team in creating resources that help local churches in the United States participate in God's work around the world.

Praise the Lord for providing the visas needed for two families eager to leave for the field. Pray for safety as they move overseas and grace as they adjust to living in an unfamiliar culture.

Pray for grace, wisdom and skill in making ongoing updates to the financial status system, praying that these changes will enable the CMCUS to better serve workers and those who support them.

Ask God to bring believers with hearts for serving among the Deaf to participate in short-term trips to the Middle East this coming spring and summer.
