

Pray Together With CHRISTAR[®]

Join us in prayer for these needs from partners in the Great Commission.

For Cross-Cultural Workers

Ask God to raise up local believers to partner with Christar workers in the United States in ministry among refugees.

Praise God for answering the prayer of workers serving among a North African community in France by leading them to people who are open to the gospel. Continue asking the Lord to bring into their lives individuals and families in whose hearts He is working.

Pray for wisdom for workers around the world as they follow up with those who attended Christmas outreaches.

Lift up workers serving as marketplace professionals in Central Asian communities where most people have never met a Christian. As they build relationships with coworkers and clients, ask God to give them opportunities to demonstrate and communicate the hope of Christ.

Ask for grace, patience and endurance for workers learning difficult languages so they can clearly share the gospel with least-reached people.

For Partner Churches

Thank God with us for the church that opens its facilities for the CMCUS to host trainings for new workers. Ask God to bless this congregation and give them joy as they participate in the Great Commission.

Praise God for members of a church in California who traveled to the Philippines to visit workers they send and to help with a church-planting conference. Ask Him to use them to encourage others to invest in ministry in this area of the world as they share about their experience overseas.

Pray with the pastors of a multi-campus church in Ohio that God will bring together key leaders in each campus to generate a path to cross-cultural ministry for members of the congregation.

Lift up the churches that sent representatives to the Chinese Missions Convention in Maryland in December. Pray they will be encouraged by what they experienced, and ask God to use them to help many in their congregations become more involved in His global work.

Pray for refreshment and renewal for leadership and volunteers at Christar partner churches after the busyness of the Christmas season.



For Missions-Minded Believers

Pray for comfort for the family members of new workers who will soon leave for the field. Ask for grace and peace as they say goodbye.

Thank the Lord with us for believers who are serving as ambassadors for Christar, partnering with us to involve more of the Body of Christ in the Great Commission. As they invest their skills and thought leadership, ask God to use them to involve more of His people in His redemptive work.

Lift up two national believers in Southeast Asia who are sharing the gospel in their community and trying to start Bible studies. Ask God to bring other followers of Jesus to partner with them in ministry and to use them to draw many to Him.

Praise God for a family beginning ministry in North Africa in January. Ask Him to give them grace as they adjust to life overseas.

Lift up several givers facing challenging ongoing health issues. Pray for endurance, comfort and wisdom for them and the family members caring for them.

For the CMCUS*

Praise God for the 19 participants expected at our New Personnel Orientation in January. As we ask God for a total of 60 NPO participants in 2025, pray that at least 41 more aspiring cross-cultural workers would begin this process in the months ahead.

Continue to ask for wisdom in creating resources that help diverse believers use their unique gifts and experience to participate in the Great Commission.

Pray for new Christar appointees as they begin building teams of prayer and financial supporters. Ask God to encourage them and meet their needs in His time.

Praise the Lord for the members of the Christar U.S. Board, who have faithfully stewarded their gifts for the work and ministry of Christar. Ask God to continue to use their guidance to steer the ministry of the CMCUS.

Pray that God would work through growing partnerships to increase funding for the CMCUS. Ask for His provision to meet critical needs as well as to continue expanding opportunities for local churches to get involved in establishing new churches among the least-reached.
