

CALL TO PRAYER

October 2020



Thursday, October 1

Praise God for dozens of Persian believers and seekers who have been attending online Bible studies. Ask Him to draw each one to Himself.

Friday, October 2

Ask God to raise up believers to partner with workers in North America serving among immigrants and refugees.

Saturday, October 3

Pray for wisdom for Christar workers seeking to begin new initiative to reach a Deaf people group in the Middle East with the gospel.

Sunday, October 4

Lift up workers who have been delayed in returning to their countries of service due to border closures. Ask the Lord to give them wisdom and patience.

Monday, October 5

On World Teachers' Day, praise God for giving many cross-cultural workers opportunities to share the gospel through roles in education! Ask Him to use them to draw their students and fellow educators to faith in Him.

Tuesday, October 6

Lift up workers participating in Pre-Departure Orientation. Pray they will be encouraged and equipped to begin full-time ministry in least-reached* communities, and ask God to give them peace as they face many uncertainties.

Wednesday, October 7

Pray that individuals in South Asia who recently received Bibles from a Christar worker will continue to be drawn to God's Word and read it faithfully.

Thursday, October 8

Praise God that workers who've had to postpone leaving for their first term of service due to COVID-19 have been able to begin language study during their time of waiting. Pray for perseverance and good progress.

Friday, October 9

Pray that a group of Muslim-background believers in Southeast Asia will continue to meet weekly for worship and fellowship.

Saturday, October 10

On World Mental Health Day, ask God to use workers ministering through counseling to bring healing and everlasting hope to least-reached people.

Sunday, October 11

Join workers in Japan in asking that they will be effective disciple-makers. They share, “Our ministry is not solely to find the lost and share the gospel with them, but to equip our believing friends to live for Christ and share the gospel with others in their lives.”

Monday, October 12

Praise God for enabling a worker in France to befriend numerous North African Muslim women. Ask God to give her opportunities to demonstrate His love and share truth with these new friends.

Tuesday, October 13

Lift up the new workers participating in part two of New Personnel Orientation this week, asking that this training will encourage them and equip them for pre-field ministry.

Wednesday, October 14

Ask God to work through a social media outreach to introduce many in the Middle East to the gospel.

Thursday, October 15

Pray that 24 new Timothy Project Bible study videos, recorded over the summer, will equip Turks around the world to apply God’s Word.

Friday, October 16

The ongoing challenges of COVID-19 have compounded the financial struggles of refugees around the world. Ask God to provide for their needs and point them to Him in the process.

Saturday, October 17

Tomorrow is the first day of Navratri, a Hindu festival that celebrates the triumph of good over evil. Pray many Hindus will know the power of Christ, who delivers us from evil.

Sunday, October 18

Praise the Lord for 11 students who recently graduated from a missions training program offered by Eagles of Peace, a Christar project in Albania. Ask Him to use each one for His glory.

Monday, October 19

Pray for wisdom for workers in South Asia seeking to start businesses that would enable them to bring tangible blessing in least-reached communities while introducing people to Jesus.

Tuesday, October 20

Praise the Lord that workers in the Middle East have seen an increase in the number of people expressing interest in the gospel. Ask Him to provide local believers to partner with them to follow up with those who want to know more.

Wednesday, October 21

Lift up the immigrant and refugee children who participated in programs in the park held by workers in North America over the summer. Pray they will recall what they learned and want to know more about Jesus.

Thursday, October 22

Pray that Central Asian families that have received food from local churches through the Persian Outreach Project will be drawn to the love of Christ that was demonstrated to them.

Friday, October 23

Praise God for answering the prayers of workers in the Middle East: Several local women have been more interested in spiritual things. Pray for continued openness to biblical truth.

Saturday, October 24

Pray for grace and, if God wills, healing for workers struggling with serious health concerns. Ask that their testimonies would point many to the hope of Christ.

Sunday, October 25

Praise God for three believers in Japan who were recently baptized! Ask Him to strengthen their faith.

Monday, October 26

As millions of Hindus conclude 10 days of spiritual focus, pray that many will find everlasting hope and peace.

Tuesday, October 27

Lift up several individuals in France who seem to be close to trusting in Christ. Ask God to overcome any barriers that are causing them to hesitate to embrace the gospel.

Wednesday, October 28

Ask God to graciously provide for the needs of the many churches and individuals who faithfully give toward the ministry of Christar workers and projects.

Thursday, October 29

Today some Muslims celebrate Muhammad's birthday. Pray that many will be reborn in Christ.

Friday, October 30

Lift up the efforts of Christar workers and Kurdish believers to reach out to Kurds in Canada via social media. Pray this initiative will facilitate connections with those who are open to the gospel.

Friday, October 31

Pray for wisdom for workers planning for Christmas outreaches in light of great uncertainties.

*Least-reached: Those without access to a church that preaches the gospel in their language and in a culturally relevant way.
