Friday, October 1

Ask God to provide an experienced manager to oversee operations of an English institute run by workers in the Middle East.

Saturday, October 2

Pray that the Lord would lead workers serving among South Asians in the United States to people in whom He is already working and who want to know about Jesus.

Sunday, October 3

Lift up new workers who are unsure when they will be able to leave for the field due to continued pandemic-related restrictions. Ask the Lord to give grace and peace amid uncertainty.

Monday, October 4

Praise God that former students of workers in Central Asia have remained committed to Christ and are sharing the good news with others.

Tuesday, October 5

On World Teachers' Day, praise God for giving many cross-cultural workers opportunities to share the gospel through roles in education! Ask God to use them to draw their students and fellow educators to faith in Him.

Wednesday, October 6

Workers serving among a minority group in the Far East share that Islam is deeply linked to this group's sense of identity. Ask God to give many from among this people an openness to the gospel.

Thursday, October 7

Today is the first day of Navratri, a Hindu festival that celebrates the triumph of good over evil. Pray many Hindus will know the power of Christ, who delivers us from evil.

Friday, October 8

Thank God for providing local language helpers for workers who recently arrived in the Middle East. Ask Him to bring similar tutors for other workers around the world.

Saturday, October 9

Praise God that a church in Japan has been growing in spite of the pandemic. Pray that members of this fellowship will mature in Christ and increase in their love for one another.

Sunday, October 10

On World Mental Health Day, pray for workers using counseling in ministry in least-reached* communities. Ask God to use them to bring healing and everlasting hope.

Monday, October 11

Pray that those who participate in the "Conversations With Christar" virtual event this evening will be encouraged to take the next step toward cross-cultural ministry.

Tuesday, October 12

Join a worker in South Asia in asking God to give many people in his city hearts that hunger for the truth.

Wednesday, October 13

Pray for wisdom for workers serving at the Lighthouse of Friendship ministry center in France as they plan creative activities to help them connect with least-reached people.

Thursday, October 14

Praise God with workers in the United States for opportunities to share the gospel with immigrants who'd never heard it before. Pray that those who were introduced to the good news will want to know more.

Friday, October 15

As millions of Asians conclude 10 days of spiritual focus, pray that many will find everlasting hope and peace in Christ.

Saturday, October 16

Pray that the pastors and church missions leaders who participated in last month's Church Partnership Summit will be able to apply the resources provided through this event to help their congregations participate more fully in the Great Commission.

Sunday, October 17

This week the Christar Mobilization Center U.S. Engagement and Advancement team is gathering for training and strategic planning. Ask God to unify this team with a vision to call, equip and encourage many to worshipfully be involved in bringing the gospel to the least-reached.

Monday, October 18

Today, some Muslims celebrate Muhammad's birthday. Pray that many will be reborn in Christ.

Tuesday, October 19

Pray for wisdom for workers seeking to open a professional development center in a community with very few believers. Ask that this endeavor will open a multitude of opportunities to share the hope of Christ.

Wednesday, October 20

Praise God for a new worker who recently arrived in the Balkans! Pray that she will form strong relationships with her teammates and in her community.

Thursday, October 21

Pray for wisdom for workers serving in the United States and overseas in planning short-term opportunities for 2022.

Friday, October 22

Praise God for the first 10 graduates from a new seminary in the Middle East! Lift up the 100-plus students currently enrolled, asking God to use their studies to equip them for effective ministry.

Saturday, October 23

Ask the Lord to call more of His people to take the gospel to the nearly 70 million least-reached Deaf worldwide.

Sunday, October 24

Pray that Muslim- and Hindu-background believers in the Netherlands will mature in faith and commit to being involved in a local church.

Monday, October 25

Ask God to use English as a second language classes held every Monday and Wednesday evening to give workers in the United States opportunities to share the gospel with least-reached people of numerous nationalities.

Tuesday, October 26

Pray with workers in South Asia that God will speak to their Muslim friends through prayer, dreams and visions.

Wednesday, October 27

Praise God for providing local churches to partner with workers in the U.S. in reaching out to refugees. Ask Him to use these congregations to give many people a desire to be part of His Body.

Thursday, October 28

Pray for courage and comfort for believers living in areas deeply impacted by political unrest. Ask that the peace of Christ will overflow in their hearts and draw others to the Savior.

Friday, October 29

Ask the Lord to guide as a new Christar mobilization center is established to recruit and equip believers from the Far East to serve among the least-reached.

Saturday, October 30

Lift up the 44 women who recently took part in “Nouara” small-group life-growth programs offered by Arab Woman Today. Pray they will continue to mature spiritually.

Sunday, October 31

Pray with workers serving among the Roma that local believers will be burdened for their unsaved family and friends.

*Least-reached: those without access to a church that preaches the gospel in their language and in a culturally relevant way
