

# CALL TO PRAYER

November 2020



## **Sunday, November 1**

On the International Day of Prayer for the Persecuted Church, pray for courage and protection for believers who are suffering for their faith. Ask God to make them lights in their communities.

## **Monday, November 2**

Lift up the families in Japan that interact with believers through Christar workers' preschool English classes and parenting classes. Pray that each one would hunger for God and His Word.

## **Tuesday, November 3**

On Election Day, ask God to work through the decisions of government leaders for His glory among least-reached\* people.

## **Wednesday, November 4**

Pray that the college students who participated in the Global Project 2020 groups led by Christar mobilizers over the summer would continue to apply what they learned about building relationships, sharing the gospel and making disciples.

## **Thursday, November 5**

Lift up the 85 women from 12 countries throughout the Arab world who participated in a discipleship course offered by the Arab Center for Consulting and Training Services, asking that they will apply what they've learned.

## **Friday, November 6**

Join workers in North America in asking God to open the hearts and minds of their South Asian friends to the gospel.

## **Saturday, November 7**

Pray for wisdom for workers around the world in planning Christmas outreaches in light of many uncertainties.

## **Sunday, November 8**

Lift up teachers serving in schools that provide education for children of cross-cultural workers, asking God to give them wisdom and creativity in adapting to ever-changing challenges.

## **Monday, November 9**

Praise the Lord for five new believers in Japan! Pray they will get involved in a church community in which they can be discipled.

## **Tuesday, November 10**

Pray for grace, peace and guidance for new workers who continue to be delayed in leaving for the field due to COVID-19.

## **Wednesday, November 11**

Praise God for bringing over 50 people from a Persian community to a worker's online English class outreach. Pray for opportunities to share the gospel with students.

**Thursday, November 12**

During Diwali, the Hindu festival of lights, pray that workers serving among Hindus will have many opportunities to share the Light of the World.

**Friday, November 13**

Praise God for a new worker who recently arrived in a Kurdish community! Pray for grace for her as she adjusts to life in a least-reached community and for good connections with local people.

**Saturday, November 14**

Pray for wisdom and grace for workers seeking to serve God among the least-reached while dealing with significant health challenges.

**Sunday, November 15**

Today many in Japan celebrate Shichi-Go-San by praying for the health and well-being of their children at a Shinto shrine. Pray for the children of this nation, asking that many will hear the gospel at a young age.

**Monday, November 16**

Ask God to give workers serving as university professors in least-reached communities abundant opportunities to share truth, whether teaching on campus or online.

**Tuesday, November 17**

Praise God for believers in the Far East who have carried on with ministry while Christar workers are out of the country. Ask Him to bring forth great fruit from their efforts.

**Wednesday, November 18**

Pray that the dozens of refugee children in the U.S. who heard Bible stories through a neighborhood outreach will be drawn to the message of grace found in God's Word.

**Thursday, November 19**

Join workers in South Asia in praying that their English students will take interest in the deeper truth found in the Bible.

**Friday, November 20**

Praise God for providing the funds needed for workers in the Philippines to distribute rice to 380 needy families. Join them in praying "that that this would not only fill their physical hunger but also open many hearts for spiritual food."

**Saturday, November 21**

Ask the Lord to bring many from a least-reached Muslim people group in the Far East into abundant life in Him through the counseling ministry of a Christar worker.

**Sunday, November 22**

Thank the Lord for blessing the perseverance of Christar workers. One worker serving among an immigrant community in North America recently saw a least-reached friend accept Christ after studying the Bible with him for a decade.

**Monday, November 23**

Pray that North Africans in France who've heard biblical truth through Christar workers would be drawn to the good news.

**Tuesday, November 24**

Lift up those in Japan who heard biblical truth and interacted with believers at community outreaches in recent months, praying they will return to the church that sponsored these events and learn more about Jesus.

**Wednesday, November 25**

Ask the Lord to use workers serving at a training center in the Middle East to equip local believers for effective ministry.

**Thursday, November 26**

Happy Thanksgiving! Give thanks to God with us for the many churches and individuals who, through their faithful prayers and giving, participate with Christar workers in ministry to the least-reached.

**Friday, November 27**

Pray with workers in the Far East that the local church “will find that being physically separated for so long will have helped us learn to not take fellowship for granted and be more intentional, full of prayer and full of love for one another.”

**Saturday, November 28**

On Small Business Saturday, lift up the numerous Christar workers building into the lives of least-reached people through roles in business, asking God to give them abundant opportunities to live out and share the gospel.

**Sunday, November 29**

Ask God to prepare the hearts of those who will hear the gospel through virtual and in-person Christmas outreaches throughout the coming month.

**Monday, November 30**

Pray that Christar’s participation in the BLESS Foundation’s Light the World virtual event next month will raise awareness of the need to send workers to reach the Deaf with the gospel.

\*Least-reached: Those without access to a church that preaches the gospel in their language and in a culturally relevant way.
