

CALL TO PRAYER

November 2021



Monday, November 1

Ask God to raise up believers in North America to partner with workers reaching out to Afghan refugees.

Tuesday, November 2

As Diwali, the Hindu festival of lights, begins, pray that workers serving among Hindus will have many opportunities to share the Light of the World.

Wednesday, November 3

Lift up three young people in the Philippines who recently accepted Christ and were baptized, praying that each one will grow in faith.

Thursday, November 4

Ask the Lord to provide the staff members needed at Cleft of the Rock in the Middle East so that this retreat center can effectively serve as a place of refuge and refreshment for workers ministering in difficult places.

Friday, November 5

A worker shares that for many people from Middle Eastern backgrounds, it is difficult to trust someone who is from a different bloodline, clan or region. Pray that those who have believed in Jesus will discover what it means to become one family in Christ.

Saturday, November 6

Ask God to use a social media outreach to connect workers in North America with Kurds who are interested in learning about the Bible.

Sunday, November 7

On the International Day of Prayer for the Persecuted Church, pray for courage and protection for believers who are suffering for their faith. Ask God to make them lights in their communities.

Monday, November 8

Lift up those involved in translating the Bible study *Through God's Eyes* into American Sign Language. Pray that the Lord will work through them to create a resource that He will use to raise up many Deaf believers to take the gospel to the least-reached* Deaf around the world.

Tuesday, November 9

Lift up two workers who recently arrived in the Middle East, asking God to give them grace as they adjust and strong connections in their new community.

Wednesday, November 10

Ask God to provide someone with accounting, bookkeeping and management skills to serve as finance officer at a school in Albania that meets the educational needs of families serving across cultures.

Thursday, November 11

Pray for all those who attended the baptism of two women in Japan and heard their testimonies. Ask that many will be drawn to the hope found in Christ.

Friday, November 12

Praise God for providing employees for a growing business as missions endeavor in South Asia. Pray for guidance for the workers running this company as they seek opportunities to cultivate Christ-honoring transformation in their community.

Saturday, November 13

Pray for wisdom for workers around the world in planning Christmas outreaches amid the ongoing challenges of the pandemic.

Sunday, November 14

Thank God for local believers who are taking on more responsibility in a church plant in the Middle East. Pray for unity and wisdom as they learn to lead.

Monday, November 15

Today many in Japan celebrate Shichi-Go-San by praying for the health and well-being of their children at a Shinto shrine. Lift up the children of this nation, asking that many will have opportunities to hear the gospel at a young age.

Tuesday, November 16

Pray with workers in the United States that they would know how to help their Afghan students and neighbors who are dealing with trauma and would have opportunities to share the hope of Jesus.

Wednesday, November 17

Praise God that a church plant in Spain just held its first baptism. Ask that the three children who publicly declared their faith will grow in their walks with the Lord.

Thursday, November 18

Lift up those who've recently attended a church in the Middle East and are seeking the truth. Ask the Lord to open their eyes and hearts to the gospel.

Friday, November 19

Ask God to use the "Blessed to be a Blessing" Giving Catalog to introduce many believers throughout the United States to ways they can make a difference in least-reached communities.

Saturday, November 20

Pray for wisdom for workers in South Asia as they seek to connect with more families in their city.

Sunday, November 21

Praise God for over a dozen refugees from Myanmar who trusted in Christ at a camp outreach over the summer. Pray that each will experience true hope in the Lord as they mature in faith.

Monday, November 22

Join a new worker in asking God to give her the ability to hear and mimic speech patterns in Arabic so she can effectively communicate the good news of Jesus.

Tuesday, November 23

Ask the Lord to use a Bible study on the book of Acts to raise up leaders within house churches in South Asia.

Wednesday, November 24

Pray for workers teaching English classes for refugees in the United States, asking that they will have opportunities to clearly convey God's love to their students.

Thursday, November 25

HAPPY THANKSGIVING! Give thanks to God with us for the many churches and individuals who, through their faithful prayers and giving, participate with Christar workers in ministry among the least-reached.

Friday, November 26

Ask the Lord to provide additional prayer and financial supporters to stand behind several workers preparing to begin long-term service.

Saturday, November 27

On Small Business Saturday, lift up the numerous Christar workers building into the lives of least-reached people through roles in business, asking God to give them abundant opportunities to demonstrate and share the gospel.

Sunday, November 28

Ask God to prepare the hearts of those who will hear the gospel during Christmas outreaches throughout December.

Monday, November 29

Praise God for giving workers in the United States new opportunities to minister to least-reached people who are open to the gospel through their connections with a campus outreach.

Tuesday, November 30

On Giving Tuesday, ask God to provide for the needs of Christar workers and projects through the generosity of the Body of Christ.
