

CALL TO PRAYER

September 2022



Thursday, September 1

Workers in Japan would like to start a new Bible study this month for those who are seeking the truth. Ask God to bring people He is preparing to hear the good news.

Friday, September 2

Praise God for 15 young people who trusted in Christ during a camp outreach in the Middle East. Pray that each one will grow in faith and have courage as they live it out in a place with few believers.

Saturday, September 3

Lift up a short-term worker serving in a medical clinic this fall. As she uses her professional skills in ministry, ask the Lord to enable her to build relationships through which she can reflect Him.

Sunday, September 4

Ask God to raise up Deaf believers to join a team preparing to minister among the Deaf in the Middle East.

Monday, September 5

Happy Labor Day! Ask God to open doors for workers seeking to establish businesses around the world that provide opportunities to tangibly bless least-reached* communities while sharing the hope they have in Jesus.

Tuesday, September 6

As classes at a professional development center in the Middle East resume this fall, ask God to bring people who are open to the gospel.

Wednesday, September 7

Lift up Christar mobilizers during this busy fall season, asking God to work through them to prompt many college students to take steps toward long-term cross-cultural ministry.

Thursday, September 8

Praise God for the individuals from numerous nations that He's brought to an after-class Bible study for ESL students in the United States. Pray each one will be drawn to Him through His Word.

Friday, September 9

Pray for unity and wisdom for Middle Eastern believers taking on leadership roles in a church plant.

Saturday, September 10

Praise God for new workers who recently arrived in South Asia after two years of unexpected delays. Ask Him to enable them to build connections with their neighbors, and pray that they will reflect Christ in these new relationships.

Sunday, September 11

Pray that the families of children who were involved in a summer soccer program in an immigrant community in the United States will participate in other outreaches throughout the fall.

Monday, September 12

Ask the Lord to provide for workers in several locations who need new vehicles to carry out their ministries.

Tuesday, September 13

Lift up the women, most of whom have not yet trusted in Christ, who participate in a Tuesday evening Bible study in the Balkans. Ask God to make Himself known through His Word.

Wednesday, September 14

Pray for wisdom for a Christar worker as he teaches Bible classes to a group of approximately 20 South Asian pastors, asking that each of these men will be equipped for more effective ministry.

Thursday, September 15

Join workers serving among Yazidis in praying that their local friends will experience the peace only found in Jesus.

Friday, September 16

Pray that recently baptized believers in the Middle East will be lights for Christ in their families and city.

Saturday, September 17

Ask God to use next month's Church Partnership Summit to encourage and equip pastors and other church leaders to involve their local fellowships in ministry among the least-reached.

Sunday, September 18

Praise God for nine new workers from South Asia who are beginning service in several locations in this region and beyond. Ask Him to meet their financial needs and to bless their ministries with abundant fruit.

Monday, September 19

Pray that those who heard the gospel at a summer barbecue outreach in Japan will recall this message of hope and return to a local church to learn more.

Tuesday, September 20

Lift up workers who began ministry in Central Asia last month, praying for grace as they acclimate to an unfamiliar culture and seek to begin building relationships in their neighborhood.

Wednesday, September 21

Ask God to provide direction regarding a new ministry initiative in South Asia. Pray for wisdom for the Christar workers and churches taking initial steps.

Thursday, September 22

Tomorrow many in Japan will pay respects to deceased ancestors as they observe Autumnal Equinox Day. Pray that faith in Christ will become part of the heritage of many Japanese families.

Friday, September 23

On the International Day of Sign Languages, ask God to use workers sharing the gospel through sign languages to introduce many least-reached Deaf to the hope of Christ.

Saturday, September 24

Ask the Lord to provide workers who recently arrived on the field with local language helpers.

Sunday, September 25

Praise God for Albanian teenagers with a desire to reach others with the good news. Ask the Lord to work through their witness and vibrant faith to bring their families and friends to faith in Christ.

Monday, September 26

Today is the first day of Navratri, a Hindu festival that celebrates the triumph of good over evil. Pray many Hindus will know the power of Jesus, who delivers us from evil.

Tuesday, September 27

Pray for protection for workers' marriages as they navigate the challenges of cross-cultural life and ministry. Pray their relationships will reflect the love of Christ for His Church.

Wednesday, September 28

Praise God for opening an opportunity for a worker to teach English at a village school in the Middle East. Pray that through this role, she will be able to build connections with people who haven't yet heard the gospel.

Thursday, September 29

Join workers in the Netherlands in praying that God will draw their Muslim friends to His grace.

Friday, September 30

Pray for wisdom in transferring leadership of the Timothy Project, which produces culturally relevant Bible studies for Middle Eastern believers, to local followers of Christ.

*Least-reached: those without access to a church that preaches the gospel in their language and in a culturally relevant way
