The Christar Mobilization Center U.S. (CMCUS) is part of a wider network of eight centers across the globe, uniquely able to help the churches in their regions continue extending the reach of the good news. Each center has local leadership passionate about mobilizing the gospel and serving the Body of Christ by providing training, resources and support structures for workers sent by churches in their areas. Christar mobilization centers exist because the Body of Christ continues to expand. As maturing churches begin sending their own to least-reached communities, mobilization centers are established to serve the Body of Christ in that region.

In 2022, the Christar International Network reported **17 New Churches** planted in least-reached communities over the past year. These local churches are each marked by five key distinctives:

- A sustainable nucleus of people who have professed faith in Christ and identified with Him in baptism
- Believers who assemble consistently in whole or in part for worship, teaching, prayer and fellowship
- Spiritually qualified leaders selected from the local church
- Regular practice of baptism and communion
- Spreading the faith locally and, if possible, abroad

The Church Partnership Team served 217 partner churches through relationships and celebrated with 11 sending churches at commissioning services for new workers.

Guided by the CMCUS Mobilizers, **432 people took their first step** toward cross-cultural service.

Pre-field coaches came alongside **39 new aspiring workers** on their path to the field.
